## **Schools' Input from Lead Lay Chaplain Joe Hopkins**

Further to our phone conversation. I was thinking for the schools slot being a pupil led and animated rosary.

- A primary and Secondary school (ideally near each other) from each trust invited to represent their trust (about 12-15 pupils from each school with 2 members of staff)
- Each Trust given a decade of the Glorious Mysteries to lead and animate
  - 1<sup>st</sup> – Resurrection – St Thomas Aquinas (Leicestershire)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> – Ascension – Our Lady of Lourdes CMAT (Nottinghamshire)
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> – Pentecost – St Teresa of Lisieux CMAT (Lincolnshire)
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – Assumption – St Ralph Sherwin (Derbyshire)
  - 5<sup>th</sup> – Coronation of Mary – Mgr John Armitage
- For each decade a group of pupils will be asked to lead the prayers but also to come up with a way of animating and explaining that mystery – this could be reading/acting/miming the scripture, creating art work, writing a reflection, lead/perform a Marian hymn, a perform a role play of how we can live out the mission/message of this mystery each CMAT would have approximately 10 min including praying the decade.
- For the 5<sup>th</sup> mystery it would be great if Monsignor John Armitage led a reflection/input/short homily on Our Lady of Walsingham connecting it to the mystery.

I have heard him preach/speak a number of times and I think he would be really engaging for the children and young people.

- We could finish then with either a short time of Adoration – as our Lady always leads us to her son and/or a symbolic placing of symbols of our CMATs under the protection of Our Lady.
- NDCYS said they can produce a video of a Marian hymn for schools to learn in advance I was thinking the CJM version of the Magnificat and As I Kneel before you to top and tale the liturgy.
- I also thought seeing as the Cathedral has the facility to that we live stream it so that all schools can have the option of watching and joining in praying with us

## **So what is needed to be done**

- Contact Walsingham to see if they are happy with this and if Monsignor John is available – Cathedral Staff
- Contact the 4 CMAT's Lead Lay Chaplain and CEO and ask them to approach a primary and secondary school to represent their CMAT – Joe
- Instructions for schools to be drawn up for what is expected of them – Joe
- Draft letter for schools to send out to get parental permission (may also need one for coming together to plan). – Joe
- Risk Assessment/Information to be sent to Joe to send to schools to help to create their Risk Assessment – Cathedral Staff
- Transport to the Cathedral (Drop off/pick up point outside Albert Hall/Nottingham Playhouse) – schools to work together to book this.
- Information for all schools including prayers of the Rosary – created by Joe shared by NRCDES
- Video tutorial of Hymns – NDCYS
- Music ministry – Joe to find people to lead.
