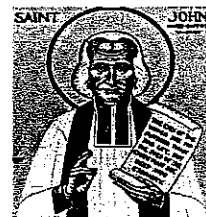

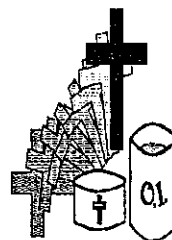

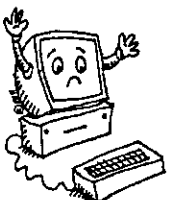


### Congratulations to Georgina, Joseph and Adam as they travel to London
