How have the SVP helped to make a difference to the lives of disadvantaged people during this last year?.....Visiting the sick and housebound, the lonely, the homeless, dysfunctional families, offenders, and people with disabilities are all examples to be found in our parishes. Food has been purchased for destitute asylum seekers through the Refugee Forum and bedding for Arimathea House that provides accommodation for refugees. A number of general requests have been received for furniture, white goods, clothing and decoration and resolved through co-operation with other charitable organisations or using SVP funds. Help for young disadvantaged people has been a priority and support directed at St Augustine's Youth Club and two sponsored places to attend The Briers chosen from our schools.
