**Today:** As you listened to the gospel, did you notice that Peter never actually apologised, or said, he was sorry. In a movie some years ago now, there was a line 'Love means never having to say you're sorry'. While this may be true, it could also be said that "Love means saying you're sorry even when you don't have to". Jesus said about the woman washing his feet with her tears 'Her many sins must have been forgiven her, because she has shown much love'. St Paul tells us love covers a multitude of sins. Peter could confess his sin, he could grovel, and beg forgiveness, or he could open his heart, and ask the Lord to look within, and see that he really did love Jesus. Peter was direct and uncomplicated. He spoke from his heart, and he knew that Jesus loved him. Because of his failures, and the many ways that he got things wrong, Peter was ideal to be put in charge of others. Earlier, he had recoiled at the idea of Jesus washing his feet, but once he understood the meaning of what Jesus was doing, he was totally open to whatever it took to be one of Jesus' disciples. Because he couldn't afford to point a finger at others, or to condemn others for the weaknesses of their humanity, he would have the necessary compassion to be a leader. To be a leader, in the midst of Jesus, was one who was prepared to be of service to others. **(MB)**
